


- Involve Parents

#### COMPARISON OF LEARNING LOSS BETWEEN SY 2019 & 2020 ON NWEA MAP





#### PARENTS' REFLECTION ON SUMMER PROGRAM




#### PARENTS PERCEPTION OF PROGRAM
